## PAINT REMOVAL INSTRUCTIONS

MATERIALS NEEDED: A straight blade (available at hardware & grocery stores), windex, paper towel, a small bucket

or garbage can. (possibly: rubbing alcohol for stubborn windows) BE EXTRA CAREFUL if you

have security film on your window as the blade can scrape that off too!!)

**SPRAY WINDOW:** \*\*Put paper towel down along the bottom ledge (to protect from falling paint bits & drips) and

spray with the paintings with windex / window cleaner (or whatever you use)

**RUB IN A LITTLE:** Use your hand & rub in the windex all over the painted areas. (that helps it soak in better)

make sure to cover all painted areas - let sit about half a minute & paint comes off easier.

(wet another section while waiting for the first one to soften)

**SCRAPE WINDOW:** With a straight blade... remove side to side or up & down... (we like to scrape upwards in

vertical strips & throw away as we go) - watch your fingers!

MARKER STILL THERE? Apply more windex to the remaining marker lines and scrape more with the straight blade.

(for extremely stubborn marker, rubbing alcohol will do the trick!)
